Carl Haag In the Footsteps of the Painter

An Excursion to Erlangen and Nuremberg to Celebrate his 200th Birthday

April 19 – 22, 2020



The German-English watercolorist Carl Haag was born almost 200 years ago – on April 20, 1820 – in the city of Erlangen. Until his death in 1915, he spent many years in the city of Oberwesel on the Rhine River, where he had a tower from the city's medival wall built into a living studio.

As the court painter for the Duke of Saxony-Coburg and Gotha, whose sister-in-law was Queen Victoria, Haag captured the life of the Queen's family in the Scottish Highlands. After stays in Rome, he spent a year traveling through the Orient in 1859. This trip produced numerous watercolors, many of which are still highly traded on the art market.

To commemorate the bicentenial of Haag's birth, the International Carl Haag Society plans to take a trip in his footsteps. This journey will take us to his birthplace in Erlangen, to his grandfather's brick factory in Frauenaurach, and to Nuremberg, the place where he trained as a painter and where he held his first art exhibitions as a member of the Dürer Association. Members of the Haag Society will provide travelers with information on the go and on site.

Itinerary

Sunday | April 19, 2020

At 10:00 A.M., our bus will depart Oberwesel from the Haag Tower (9:00 A.M. from Koblenz) and drive to Würzburg. Carl Haag often visited his mother Babette and his brother Conrad here at Sanderglacis Street. After lunch, we'll continue our trip and arrive at our hotel in Erlangen around 5:00 P.M.

Monday | April 20, 2020

In the morning, we'll celebrate Carl Haag's 200th birthday in front of his birth house on Theater Street, where he was born as the son of a baker. The mayor will join us. Afterwards, a city tour will take us to the Neustädter Church, whose ceilina paintings alwavs impressed Haag. In the afternoon, we'll visit the former brick factory of his grandfather Nikolaus Weber in Frauenaurach - where Haag spent his childhood - as well as the museum in the Amtshausschüpfla. In the evening, you are welcome to learn more about Carl Haag's adventure-filled life during a lecture by his biographer, Dr. Walter Karbach, at the city museum (optional).

Tuesday | April 21, 2020

After a reception in the town hall, the city museum will show us a selection of Carl Haag's most beautiful works from its collection. Around noon, we'll drive to Nuremberg for a guided tour of the old Imperial Castle, where the young Haag always found motifs for his drawings. In the late afternoon, we'll make our way back to Erlangen.

Wednesday | April 22, 2020

Enjoy Erlangen on your own in morning. After lunch, we'll start the journey home.
